

Equivalence Guidance for Core Programmes

Intensive Care Medicine does not have its own core training but instead accepts trainees from the following programmes:

- Acute Care Common Stream (Acute Medicine, Anaesthetic and Emergency Medicine)
- Core Anaesthetic Training
- Core Medical Training

Equivalence for these core programmes MUST be sought through the respective College's process. The FICM does NOT manage equivalence to our parent College's core programmes.

Anaesthetics (via CAT or ACCS)
